Configuring Home City, Time and Date Settings

Configure Home City and summer time settings first. After that, configure time and date settings.



1. In the Timekeeping Mode, hold down (A) for at least three seconds until the city code flashes. This is the setting mode.

2. Press © to move the flashing in the sequence shown below to select settings.








