## Crown Operations

Some water-resistant models ( 100 meters, 200 meters) have a screw-in crown. When you need to perform a crown operation, rotate it towards you to unscrew it. Then pull the crow its water resistance while the crown is unscrewed After performing a crown operation, fully screw the crown back in


If your watch has a rotary bezel...
You can rotate the bezel to align its $\boldsymbol{\nabla}$ mark with the minute hand. Then you will be able to tell how much time has elapsed since aligning the $\boldsymbol{\nabla}$ mark
