


BEFORE USING THE CALCULATOR FOR THE FIRST TIME...


 Push the battery compartment cover on the back of the calculator in the direction noted in the illustration and remove it.



- 2. Load the two batteries that come with calculator.
- Make sure that the positive (+) and negative (-) ends of the batteries are facing correctly.



3. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place, and then press the RESET button on the back of the calculator with a thin, pointed object. When you do, the RESET screen illustrated nearby appears.



4. Press **F1** (YES) to reset the calculator.





5. Press MENU .



6. Use the cursor keys (, , , ,) to select the **CONT** icon and press **EXE** or simply press **7** to display the contrast adjustment screen.

 to make the figure on the screen lighter or
 to make them darker.
- 8. After getting the contrast the way you want it, press (MENU) to return to the main menu.
